Initial payment and Jersey size due

\$100

March 1st, no meeting

Remaining balance due (remaining team dues and jersey money if necessary)

Up to \$250

(Updated balance at the 1/14/2010 meeting)

By February 15th

Equipment (7 items: black helmet, shoulder pads, arm pads, gloves, stick, athletic cup, and mouthpiece)

Up to \$250

Equipment: New equipment will cost around \$250 and can be bought at MC Sports or online at www.stickheadlax.com, www.lax.com, www.lacrossemonkey.com, or Google “lacrosse equipment.” Used equipment can be found on e-bay.

Here's what you do:

If you can get your hands on used equipment, it's the cheapest. Otherwise...

Step 1: Look online for prices

Step 2: Go to MC Sports to try on equipment and write down sizes

Step 3: Buy the best price

Helmets: must be black, preferably with orange chin & visor. Lax websites will have that option for no extra charge. Go to MC Sports and find your size before buying a helmet. Cascade CLH2 is the most popular at \$115, but Riddell is much better at \$155.

Lacrosse Sticks: You can look around and read reviews for heads, www.lax.com/shop/lacrosse-heads.html, and handles, www.lax.com/shop/lacrosse-shafts.html

For a complete stick, you'll spend at least forty dollars. Beginner sticks that coach recommends: store.stickheadlacrosse.com/stxprheampal.html or store.stickheadlacrosse.com/mabacost.html (I found these pretty quick. So do your own research to see what's wrong with these sticks. You can also find sticks at www.lacrossemonkey.com/complete-attack-sticks.html).
